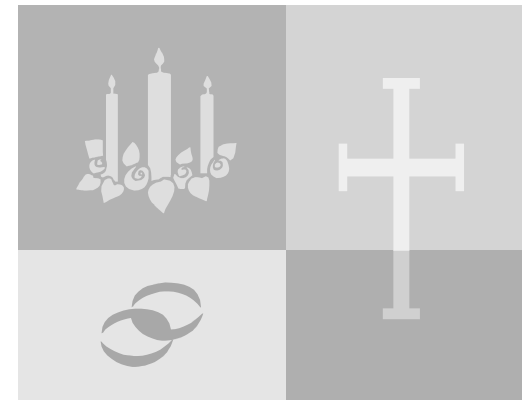

Marriage -- a wonderful gift, an awesome responsibility

Marriage is a wonderful gift – and an awesome responsibility. The celebration of marriage as a sacrament is not a one-time event, but a life-long vocation. God has a plan for marriage, and he wills it to be something wonderful. Marriage presents special challenges, but it can also be one of the most fulfilling experiences of being human.

This four-part marriage preparation series presents an overview of the Church's teachings on the sacrament of marriage and how these teachings impact the practical ways in which we live out our marriage.

In four consecutive weekly sessions, couples will explore four key aspects of the marital relationship – faith, communication, sexuality, and stewardship – all presented in the context of a sacramental view of marriage.

Each session will include both group and couple prayer experiences, presentations on Church teachings, and opportunities for reflection and discussion.



SESSION ONE: MARRIAGE AND FAITH

This session will begin by defining and discussing sacrament. Participants will gain an understanding of marriage as a sign of Jesus' relationship with the Church and the married couple as a sign of the Holy Trinity (Genesis 1:27).

SESSION TWO: MARRIAGE AND COMMUNICATION

The context of sacrament will be used to explore how married couples are called to interact and communicate with one another, how this theology calls us to express ourselves and listen to one another. Forgiveness and reconciliation in the marital relationship will also be discussed.

SESSION THREE: MARRIAGE AND SEXUALITY

This session will discuss the basic concepts of Pope John Paul II's *Theology of the Body* and how these ideas apply to marital sexuality. We will discuss how the sexual relationship is called to reflect the total gift of self to one another and the reasoning behind often-misunderstood Church teachings, such as the Church's prohibition of contraception. Couples will also be offered an introduction to Natural Family Planning as a method of delaying or achieving pregnancy that is fully compatible with God's plan.

SESSION FOUR: MARRIAGE AND STEWARDSHIP

This session will focus on the gifts we have from God and how we nurture and share those gifts in the context of marriage. Topics include children as gifts from God, managing time and financial resources, and sharing our talents with our Church and community.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Location: Weeknight sessions of "Together in God's Image" are usually held from 7:00 to 9:00 pm at the Diocese of Austin Pastoral Center. (See registration form for details).

Cost: The cost of the four-session series is \$155 per couple, and **includes dinner at 6:30pm before each class.**
